## **EIGHT GLEN ROCK ARTISTS TO PARTICIPATE IN ARTS AMBLE 2022 – June 10-12, 2022**

GLEN ROCK, May 12, 2022 – Eight Glen Rock-based artists will be participating in Arts Amble 2022, a Bergen County art crawl event taking place in 21 municipalities, with more than 200 artists overall. Arts Amble takes place Friday, June 10 from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m., and Saturday and Sunday, June 11 and 12 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This family-friendly, fun-filled weekend of arts and culture is for all ages and is hosted by Creative Bergen. In addition to Glen Rock, this year's Arts Amble locations include Allendale, Cliffside Park, Closter, Englewood, Fair Lawn, Hackensack, Hillsdale, Mahwah, Maywood, New Milford, Oakland, Oradell, Ramsey, Ridgefield Park, Ridgewood, River Edge, Rochelle Park, Rutherford, Westwood, and Wyckoff.

**Glen Rock artists include** Watercolors by Pat Smythe, Lisa Hahn Studio stained glass windows and mosaics, Charlie Saulenas of Everwood Turnings, Soo Soo Designs, Munay Art Studio by Wendy Villa, Flor Pottery, The Smoke Artist, and Aesro Design Studio.

Samples of each artists' work will be on display at the **Glen Rock Public Library** during the month of June 2022.

County-wide, the public can explore artwork in a variety of locations, from artists' front lawns to local galleries, studios, municipal buildings, and arts festivals to take in all Bergen County has to offer. Artists of a variety of mediums are participating in this event, showing paintings, photography, sculpture, stained glass, woodwork, metal work, dance, theater, live book readings, musicians, singers, and more.

The Arts Amble is a free event in nearly all venues, and open to the public. Standard hours are Friday 5-8 p.m. and Saturday & Sunday 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., unless otherwise noted. Printed brochures with a list of participants, schedule of events and further information will be available at select locations throughout the county.
