ANNOUNCES 4th ANNUAL \$1,000 EMERGING ARTIST AWARDS  
FOR GLEN ROCK HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS  
Application Deadline is May 1, 2026**

**GLEN ROCK, N.J., March 27, 2026** – The Arts Council of Glen Rock (ACGR) is proud to recognize and support five 2026 graduating seniors from Glen Rock High School with a \$1,000 Emerging Artist Award. Applications for the award are now being accepted from March 27 through May 1, 2026.

In its fourth year of awarding scholarships, ACGR is accepting submissions based on a student's affinity for the arts either in or outside the classroom. College-bound students who wish to apply for the award aren't required to pursue an arts-related major/course of study.

Applicants can apply for more than one award, but are eligible to receive only one scholarship:

- **The Deborah Sissman Studio Arts Award** – For a student showing talent in Drawing, Painting, Illustration, Sculpture, Art Ceramics, Textiles Arts, Metalwork, Graphic Design, and/or Computer Graphics.
- **The Will Wood Performing Arts Award** – For a student showing talent in Music, Theater, Dance, Vocal Performance, Poetry and/or Scriptwriting.
- **The Barry Rubinow “Banded Together” Filmmaking Award** – For a student showing talent in creating Film, Video, and/or Television.
- **Woll Family Fund Photography Award** – For a student showing talent in the Photographic Arts.
- **Arts Career Award** – For a student planning to continue studies in the arts. Includes Teaching (any aspect of the arts), Set Design, Theater Management, Stage Performance Direction, Music Direction, Gallery/Museum Management, etc.
